

“Bag less days” *observed every Saturday to foster creativity and learning more fun. Mock elections were conducted. Water conservation project was done.*



“Formation of Cyber Club in School”



The school premises was filled with the feeling of Patriotism. Many enthralling dances and drill displays were performed with a flamboyant spirit.






