

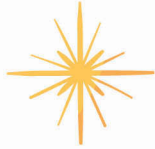

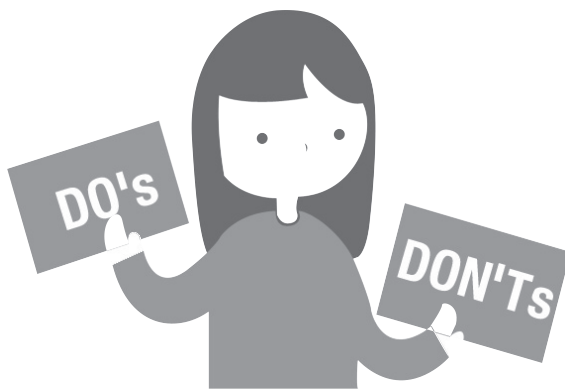

Do's for the Students

- ✓ Students are expected to be inside the school campus at least 15 minutes before the first bell.
- ✓ They should bring their books as per their class timetable.
- ✓ Students must maintain silence within and outside the classrooms and inside the school campus.
- ✓ While going from their classrooms to the library, the laboratory, the play area, the computer room etc., and vice-versa, they must form a queue and go quietly without causing disturbance to others.
- ✓ Students are advised to bring their lunch boxes while coming to school. They are forbidden from receiving the same from parents/ outsiders when their classes are in progress.
- ✓ Students must eat their snacks/ lunch in their classrooms with a napkin placed under their lunch boxes. They are expected to keep their classrooms neat and clean.
- ✓ Students themselves are responsible for the things they bring to the school.
- ✓ Students are advised to converse in English in the school premises except in 2nd & 3rd language periods.
- ✓ Students must duly complete the work assigned to them in all the subjects.
- ✓ Students should keep their notebooks properly maintained. Periodical inspection of the same will be done by the Principal / Vice-Principal/ Headmistress / CC / Subject Teacher.
- ✓ Students should be well disciplined in the absence of teachers (Period change), during intervals & lunch break.
- ✓ Students must come to school in neat, ironed and proper uniform with well-polished shoes.
- ✓ Students must wear the sports uniform with cap on Fridays, on Games Day and on any other day as instructed by the school.
- ✓ During examination days also, students must wear the uniform prescribed. Any deviation in this regard will result in deduction of marks.
- ✓ Students must come in school uniform whenever they attend Remedial / Special classes.
- ✓ Hair should be neatly combed. Boys should always maintain a short haircut. Girls with long hair must tie their hair with black ribbons on all days.
- ✓ All students should have short nails.
- ✓ Girl students are advised to wear decent dress on their birthdays.
- ✓ Students are advised to come to school on time. If anybody is found repeatedly coming late to school for more than five times, he / she will be sent home.
- ✓ The students with incomplete notes have to stay back after the school hours with the respective teachers to complete their notes.
- ✓ Attendance is compulsory for all National Festivals & Special classes.
- ✓ Students coming to school by cycle must use cycle locks compulsorily.
- ✓ In case of loss of Report Cards (Periodic Test/Term/Annual) a duplicate copy of the report card can be obtained from the school office on payment of a requisite fee as decided by the school.
- ✓ Similarly, in case of loss of school diary or school identity card, a requisite amount will be charged for reissue.



Don'ts for the Students

- ✗ Students are prohibited from leaving the premises without the written permission from the Principal / Vice-Principal / Headmistress.
- ✗ Students are advised not to bring money more than what is required for their travelling.
- ✗ Students are prohibited from running or shouting in the classrooms, staircases, corridors and on the ground.
- ✗ Causing damage to the school furniture, writing or carving on the walls or desks will make the student liable to pay the damage charges.
- ✗ Loitering in the corridor or leaning on the parapet wall is strictly prohibited.
- ✗ Eating lunch in the corridor or on the staircase is prohibited.
- ✗ Chewing gum or eating junk food is strictly prohibited in the school.
- ✗ Except in case of emergencies, the students will not be allowed to use the school telephone. The charges for the same will be collected from the student.
- ✗ Students are advised not to litter their classrooms and use the bins that are provided in each classroom and corridors.
- ✗ They are prohibited from bringing fancy watches, smart watches, cell phones, digital cameras, pen drives, CDs, tattoos and other fancy articles.
 - a) Students of primary classes are prohibited from wearing watches to school.
 - b) Students of secondary classes are prohibited from wearing alarm watches/fancy watches/smart watches to school.
- ✗ Attires pertaining to religious rituals are not permitted in school.
- ✗ Students must avoid speaking in any other local languages in the school premises.
- ✗ Girl students are prohibited from wearing flowers, fancy ear rings, anklets, fancy hair bands & clips and growing long nails with nail polish.
- ✗ Students are prohibited from writing on the green board in the absence of the teacher.
- ✗ Students are prohibited from standing or loitering in groups in and outside the school campus.
- ✗ Students are not allowed to come out of the classes after every bell.
- ✗ Cycle usage by friends is forbidden.
- ✗ Permission during examinations will not be granted.

A Note To Parents

- I.** a) Parents should send their children to school at least 15 minutes before the scheduled time. The school gate will be closed after the first bell. Late comers will not be allowed to enter the school by any means.
b) Parents accompanying their children will not be permitted to stay within the campus after the First bell.
c) Parents of Kindergarten students are allowed to pick up their children 10 min. before the scheduled time.
d) Parents should not take their children home during school hours.
e) In case the child is having any health issue, Parents should not send their wards to school and even during examination days.
f) The working hours of the school might change during the Board / Public Examinations.
- II.** a) Parents should see that they do not allow their wards to carry any fancy or valuable items to the school.
b) If the child is ill, the parents are advised not to send him / her to school. In case of a medical leave, an application accompanying the medical certificate should be submitted to the concerned Academic Head - Principal / Vice-Principal / Headmistress at the earliest.
c) Parents must inform the concerned Academic Head - Principal / Vice-Principal / Headmistress in writing, along with a medical certificate, in case their child is suffering from any serious medical ailments like Diabetes, Asthma etc., which need immediate medical attention.
d) Parents may note that causing damage to the school property by their wards is liable to penalty charges as per school norms.
e) A healthy relation between the school and the home is in the best interests of the student. Any problem relating to their wards can be smoothly and amicably resolved by meeting the authorities. To keep parents abreast with their ward's performance and for them to collect their report cards, a parent-teacher interaction (PTI) is organized four times in a year i.e., first PTI after PA-1, Second PTI after Half-Yearly Examination, third PTI after PA-2 and the fourth PTI will be after Annual Examinations. Attendance of Parents on PTI is mandatory.
f) Presence and cooperation in the cultural activities and other programs conducted at the school can surely make it all a grand success.
- III.** a) Parents should take special interest in the child's studies. It is to be noted that being absent for an examination will mean "zero marks" for the student in that particular subject.
b) Parents should ensure receipt of the report cards after every examination. This is in view of the fact that some students tend to forge their parents' signature in case of poor performance in their examinations. The school doesn't take responsibility for any such lapses.
c) Test papers and Report cards should be sent to school within three days from the date of issue. Any change in marks, ranks or grades will not be entertained after the said period.
d) At home, the parents should ensure that their children are given ample and proper time to study and do their homework. Watching television by the elders at home while the children study or do their homework can prove to be a disturbance to them.
e) Parents should spare time to check the written and test performance of their children at home.
f) Any problem relating to the school and academics should be discussed with the Principal / Vice-Principal / Headmistress or the staff during the school hours only and not over the telephone or even in person after the school hours.
g) Parents to check their ward's school diary regularly with regard to irregularities (if any) of their wards which will be recorded by the class counsellor in the school diary.
- IV.** a) Special classes for classes 6 to 10 will be held from the date as notified by the school authorities as per the timings at the MVP School.
b) Special classes for Class 10 at the Ukkunagaram School will be held from the date as notified by the school authorities as per the timings mentioned in the diary.
c) The students are supposed to wear their school uniforms for their remedial / special classes.
d) Remedial / Special classes will be held for other higher classes with prior intimation by their respective teachers.
- V.** a) Once recorded, no changes in the date of birth and other details will be made by the school authorities.
b) Any change in the address should be intimated to the class counsellor / school office in writing.
c) Parents may note that they must make their own arrangements for transportation during parent teacher interaction, competitive examinations (if held outside), Class 10 board exams etc. No teacher shall accompany the students.
d) The school will not own the responsibility of handling any dispute in case any payment like term fee, examination fee etc, is paid by the school contingent staff on behalf of the parents. Hence, parents are advised not to make any payments to the school through the school contingent staff.

A note to Parents (for city school only)

Lunch pass: The school has introduced 'Lunch Pass System' from the academic year 2015-16 for the students going home for lunch regularly and to restrict the movement of other students outside the school unnecessarily.
Parents are requested to furnish the details for availing lunch pass at the time of submitting the details for student ID card.

Learning Tips For Improvement In Students

At School

- ✓ Be attentive, have eye contact with the teacher when she / he is explaining.
- ✓ Improve your listening skills in each subject in the class.
- ✓ Improve your concentration and memory by disciplining your mind and body.
- ✓ Participate actively in Teaching/Learning Programmes of your class.
- ✓ Raise doubts if you don't understand.
- ✓ Discuss the subject with your friends now and then.
- ✓ Try to improve the skills required in each subject.



At Home

- ✓ Self-learning is the best learning.
- ✓ Learning must be regular and consistent.
- ✓ Develop the ability to comprehend whatever you read.
- ✓ He/She must relate the learning in school to home.
- ✓ He/She must have regular study habit with proper study - time table that can be implemented practically.
- ✓ Set a congenial atmosphere for your studies at home.
- ✓ Set daily goals to achieve in your subjects.
- ✓ All the fundamental concepts must be learnt thoroughly.
- ✓ He/She must discourage rote learning.
- ✓ Recapitulate important points after reading.
- ✓ Try to retain what is learnt through repetitive and periodical learning.
- ✓ Give extra time for difficult subjects on holidays.
- ✓ Do your assignments and home works correctly without fail.
- ✓ By doing simple projects/activities learning becomes more contextual, relevant, updated and builds up self confidence in students.
- ✓ Don't postpone what you can do today.
- ✓ Don't attend tuitions for long hours. Too much dependence on others kills your creativity in learning and thinking. If you are attentive in the classroom and regular in your study - habit, you won't require to attend tuitions.
- ✓ Use the mobiles/laptops only for educational purposes. Being active on social media leads to distraction and thereby affects your performance in academics too.

Leave/Absence

1. Students are expected to attend classes regularly.
2. Every student must be present on the day preceding and succeeding a vacation.
3. Leave is not granted for the first and the last working day of a term.
4. In case of sudden illness or any emergency situation, parent must notify the Principal, Vice-Principal or Headmistress in person or by an email. In case of illness, medical certificate is required to be submitted along with the leave letter.
5. Leave will be considered subject to the prior submission of leave letter to the school authorities and will be approved by the Principal/ Vice-Principal/Headmistress (for more than three days), and by the Class Counsellor (for one to three days).
6. As a general rule, leave is not granted during any examinations as there is no practice of conducting re-examination under any circumstances.
7. In case of serious illness or unavoidable situation during the examinations, the parent must submit a leave letter along with a medical certificate immediately to the concerned Academic Head.
8. Parents are requested not to allow their wards to stay at home during their revision tests.
9. A minimum of 85% of attendance is required for promotion to the next higher class.

10. Students having shortage of attendance shall be detained in the same class inspite of their good performance in academics.

11. A student of class 10 with less than 75% attendance will not be allowed to appear for Board Examinations as per CBSE rules.

12. Leave letters must be submitted as per the guidance given below.

School Hours

The school emphasises on punctuality, as it is the foundation for discipline in life. This habit must be inculcated in the students from an early age. Parents are advised to see to it that their children come to school regularly, and in time. At the time of dispersal, students must leave the school campus after the long bell is given. If enrolled for any evening activity/games/sports, students must disperse within 10 minutes after the completion of the activity/games/sports.

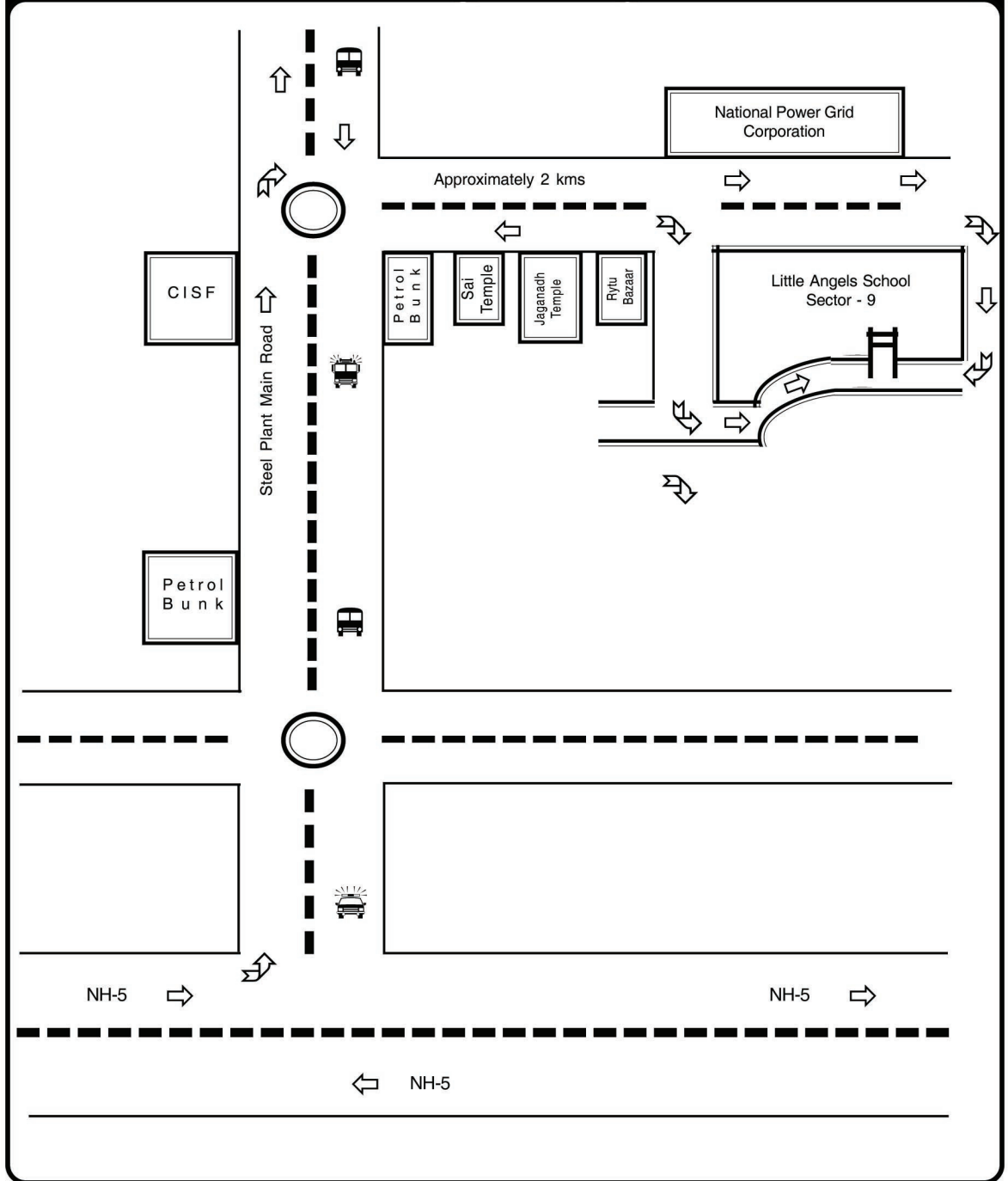
