COMMENCEMENT OF SEWA PROGRAMME

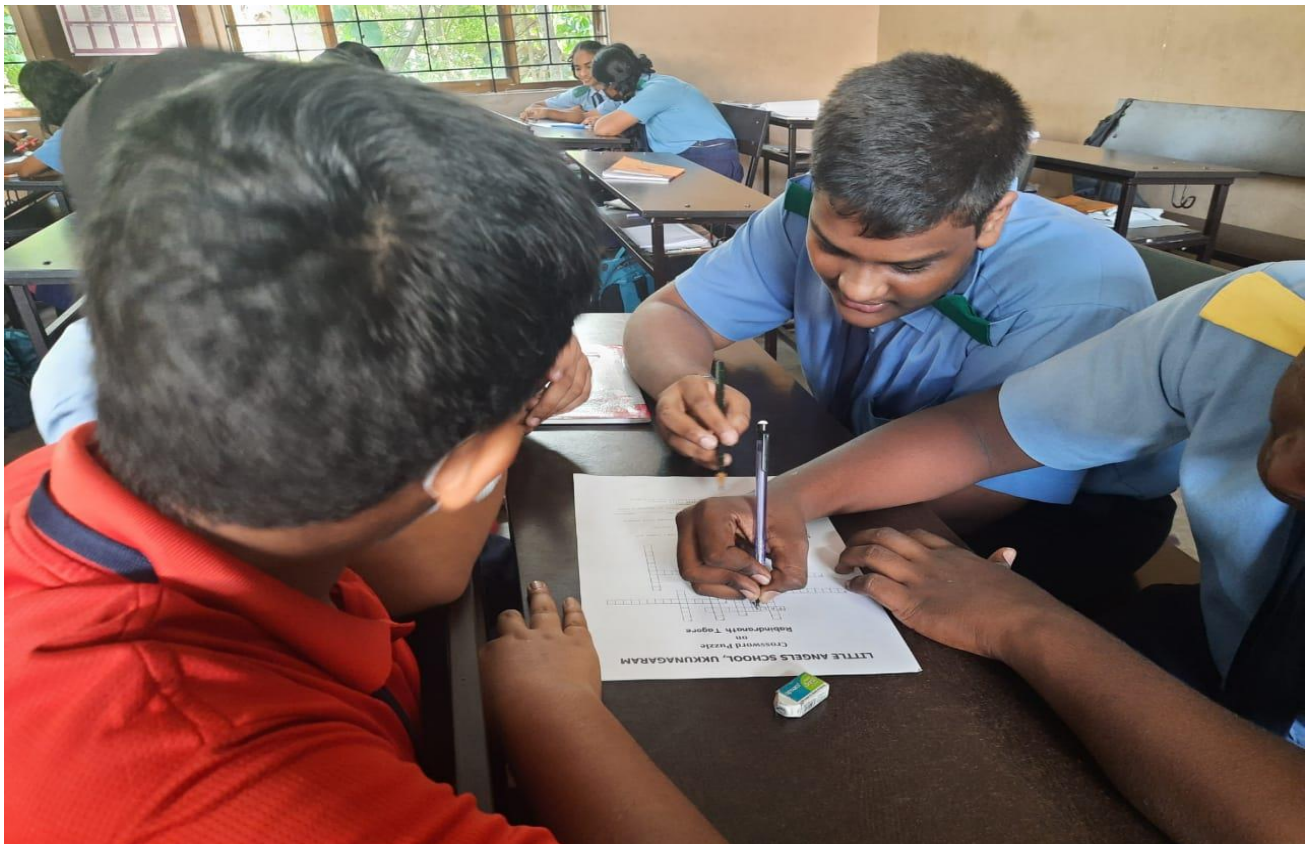
