Students interacted with parents and explained them about the Principles of 3R's.

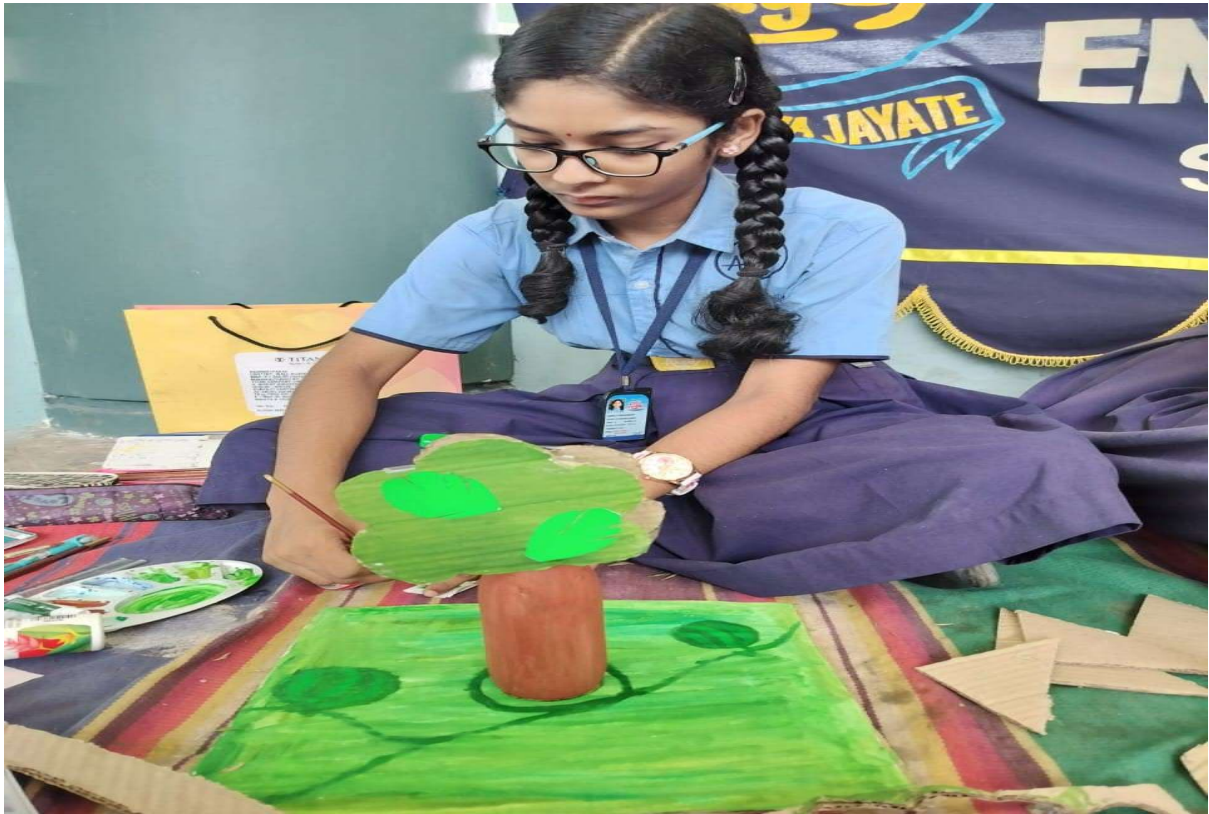

For classes 4 & 5, 'Draw your Family Tree' was conducted.



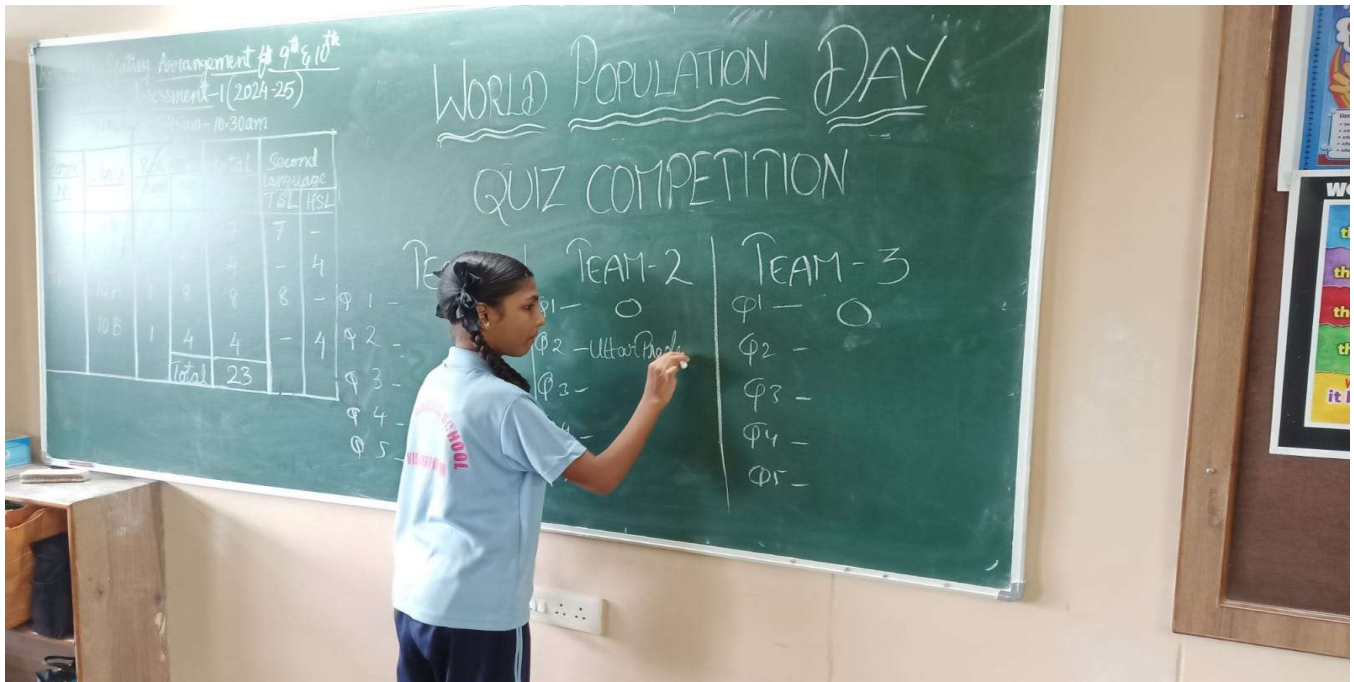
Logo designing on 'World Population' Day was conducted for the students of classes 6th & 7th.

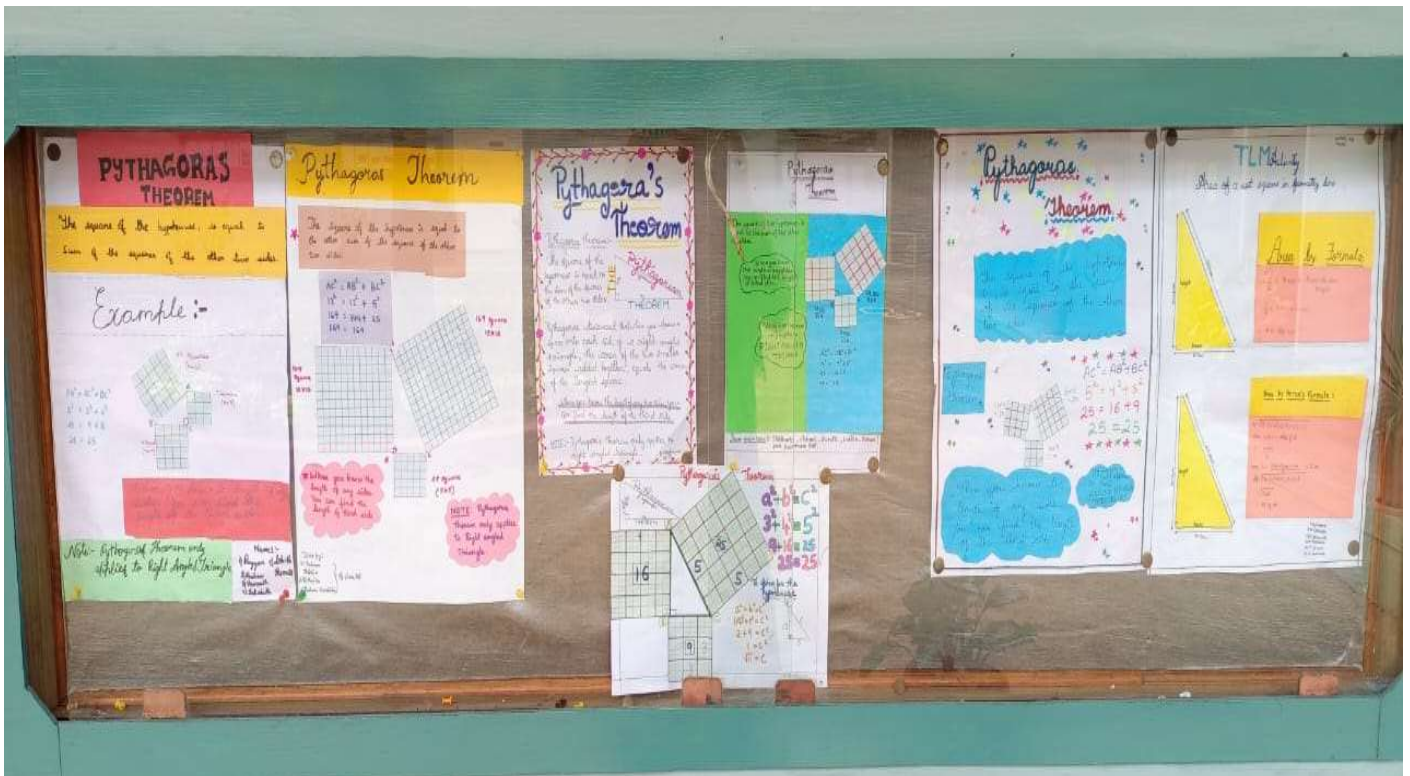
PYTHAGORAS DAY
