The teachers shared their thoughts and words of encouragement reflecting on their experiences with the students.



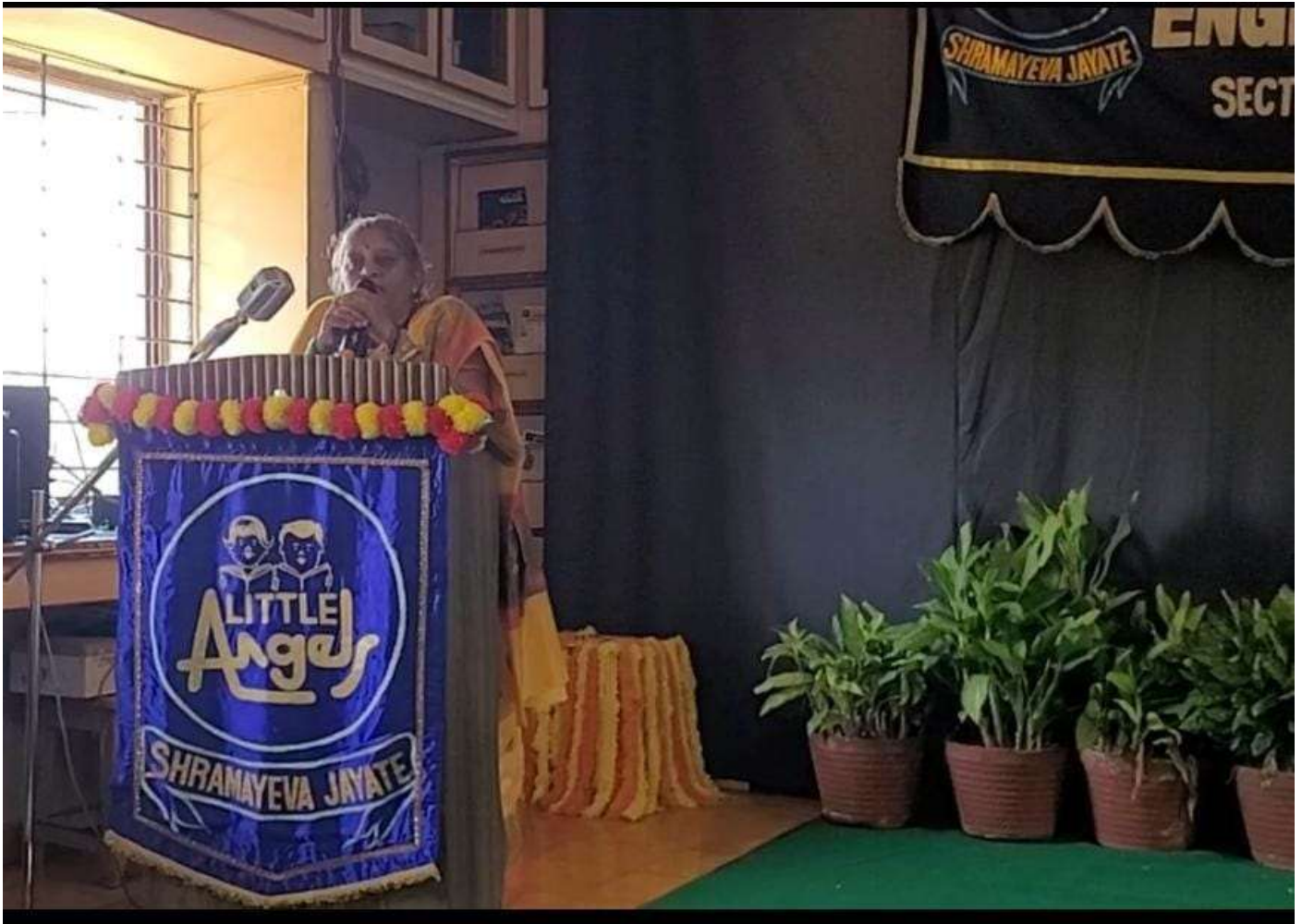
The cultural segment continued with a graceful classical dance, fusion dance leaving the audience spell bound.
