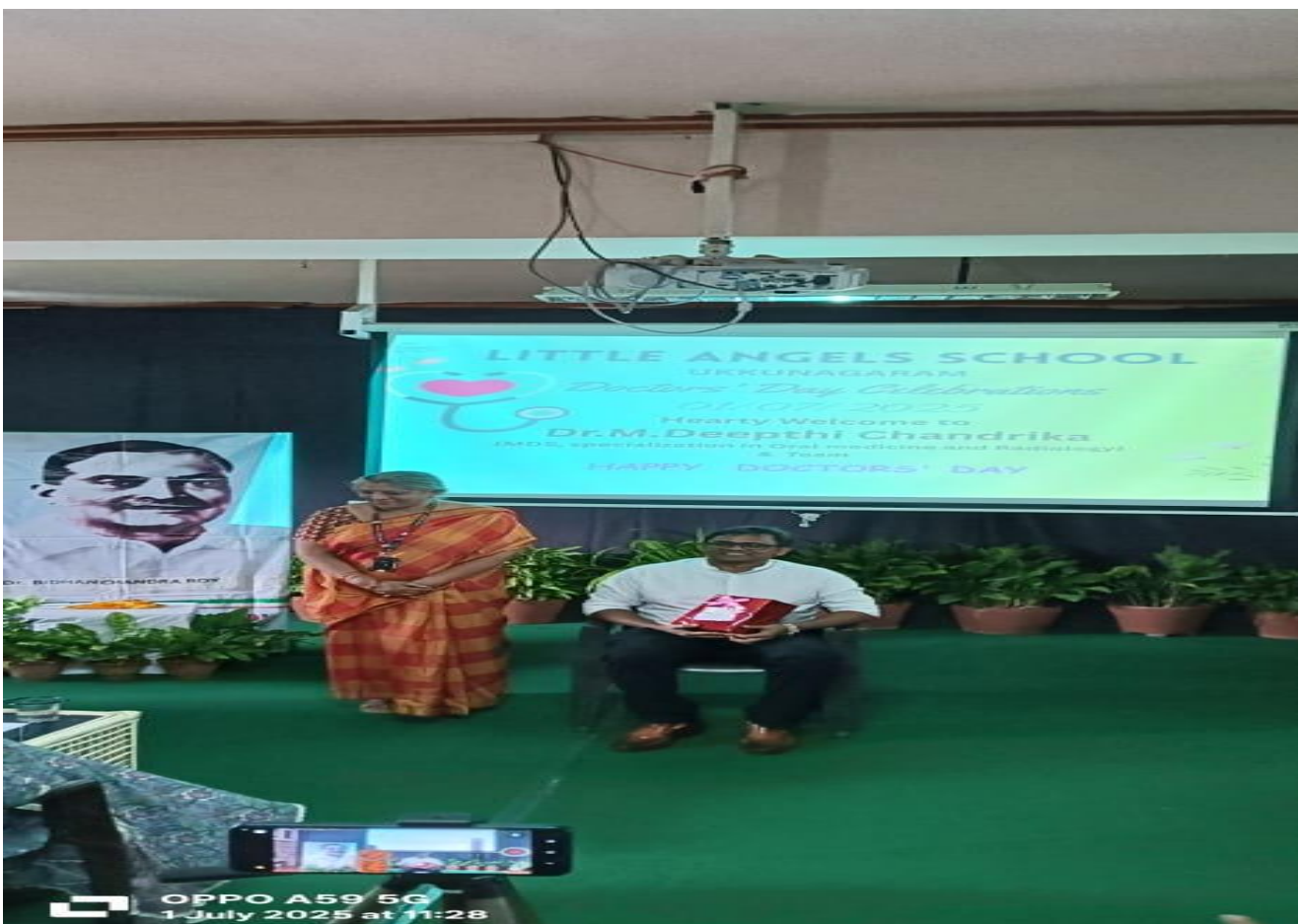
“HEALING HANDS, CARING HEARTS- THANK YOU DOCTOR’S”!

“LITTLE MINDS, MIGHTY DREAMS”

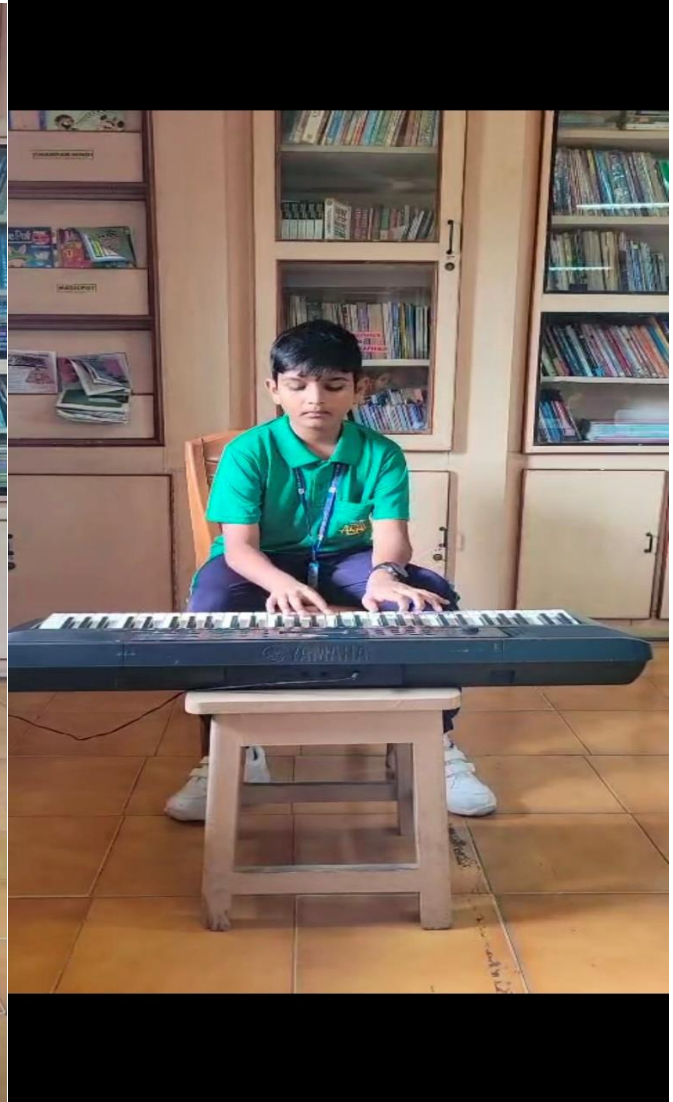
Each student introduced their future ambition with lot of confidence and clarity.

“EVERY TREE SAVED IS A BREATH OF FRESH AIR FOR FUTURE GENERATIONS.”

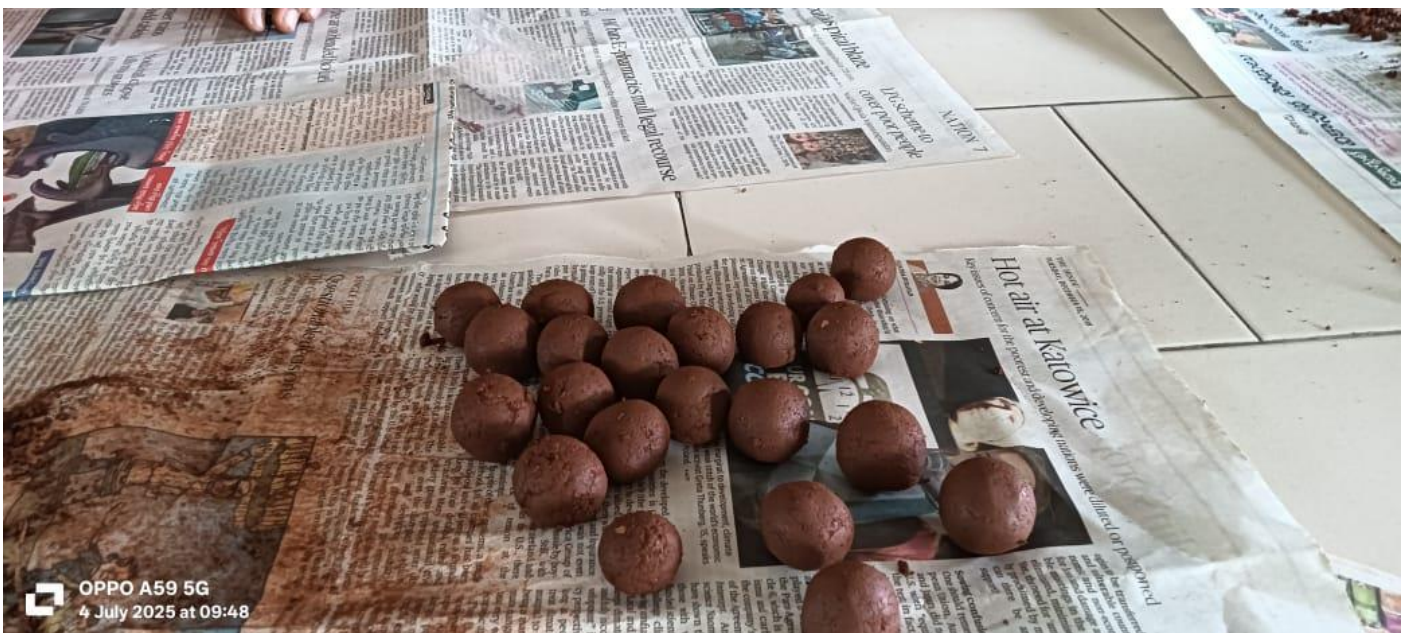

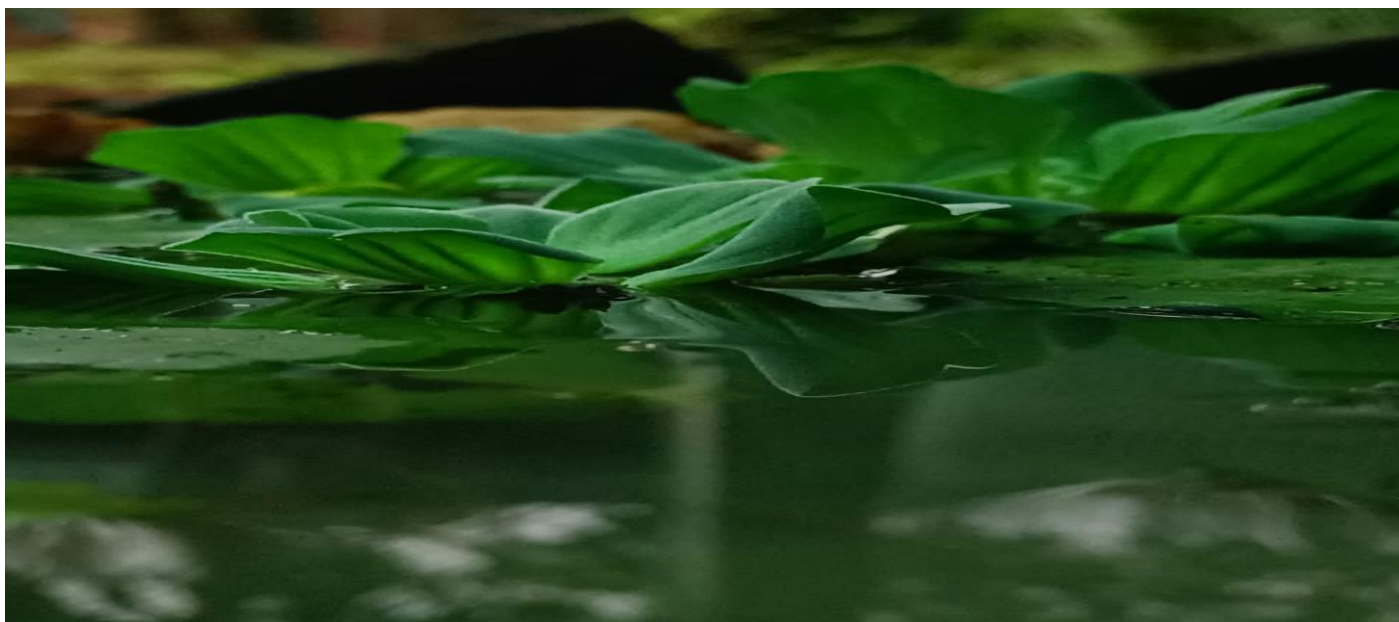
This event encouraged the children to explore the beauty of nature and celebrate the wonders of the natural world.

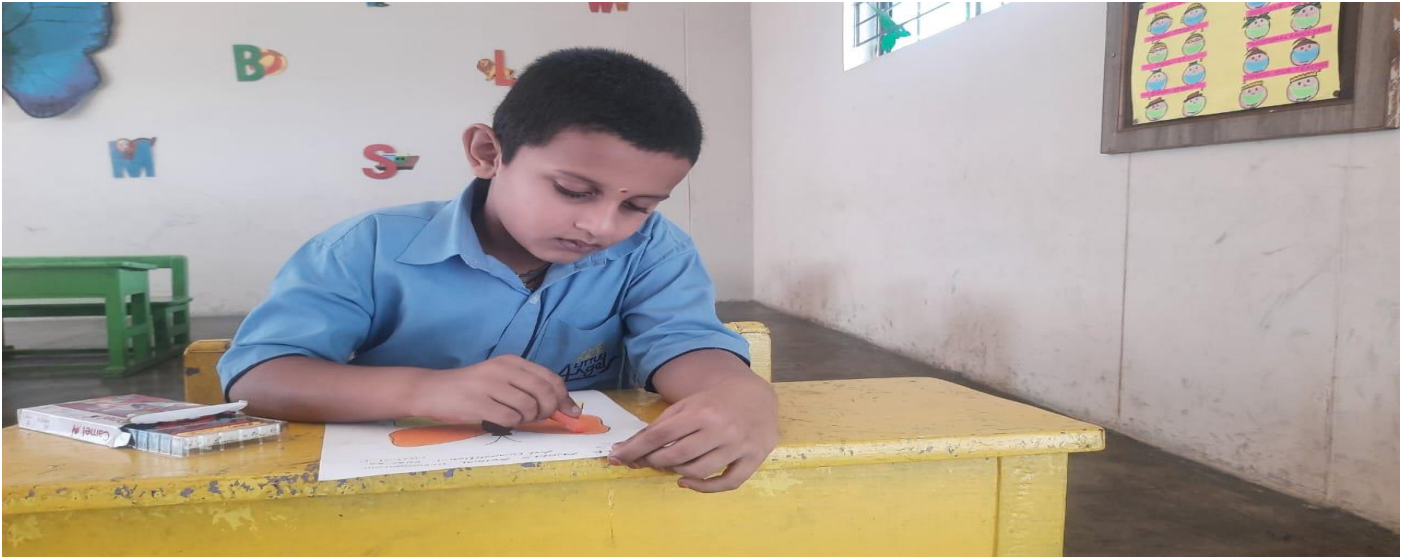
They appreciated the students enthusiasm and encouraged them to continue being green ambassadors of the future .

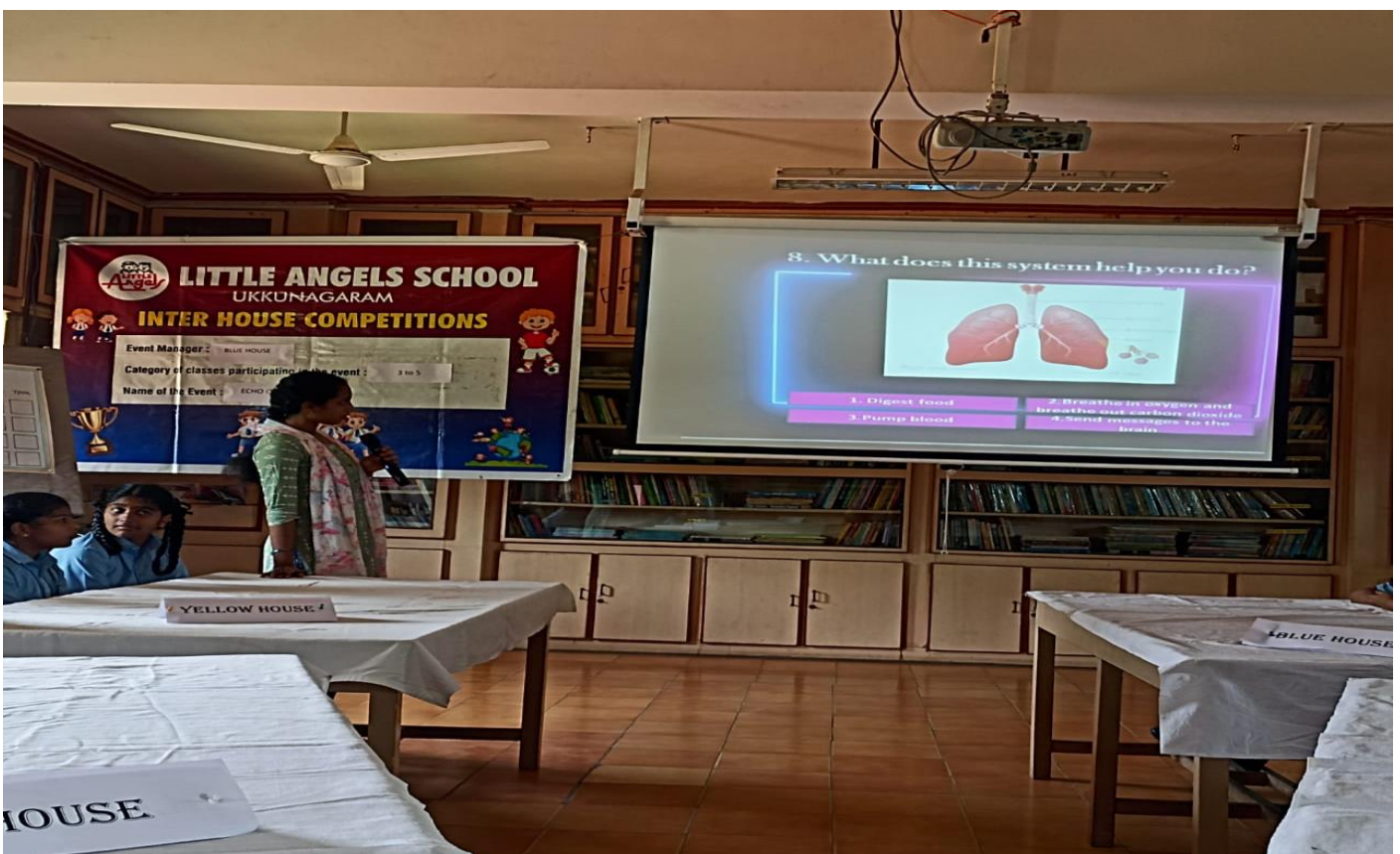
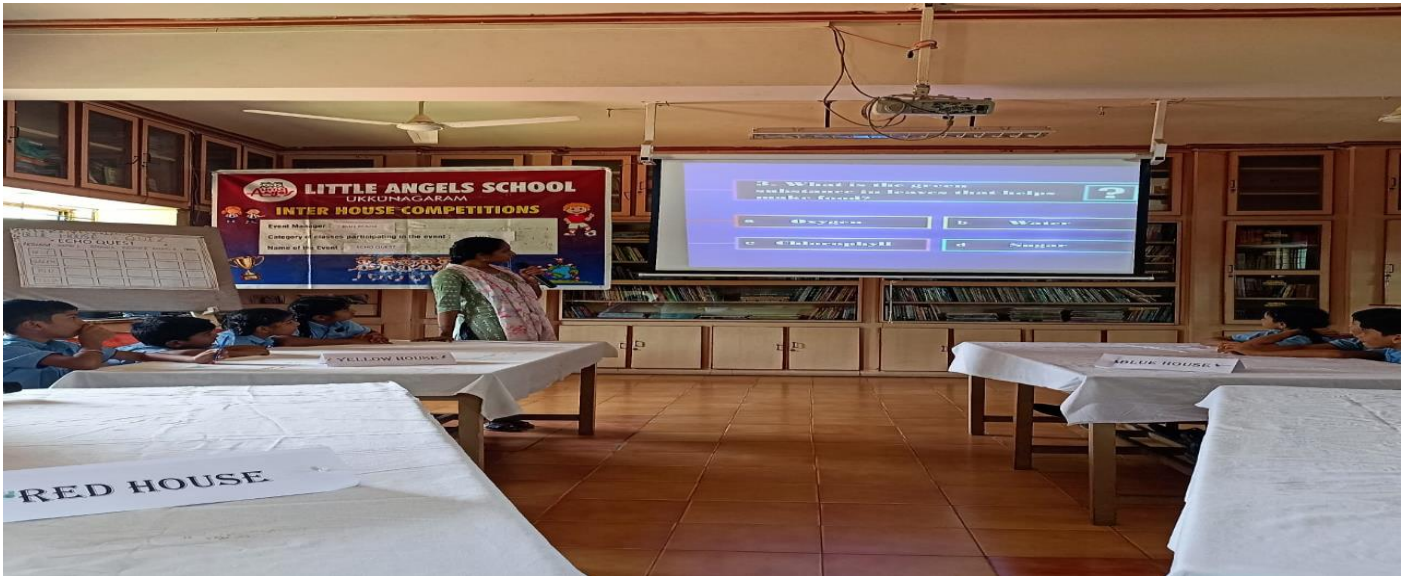

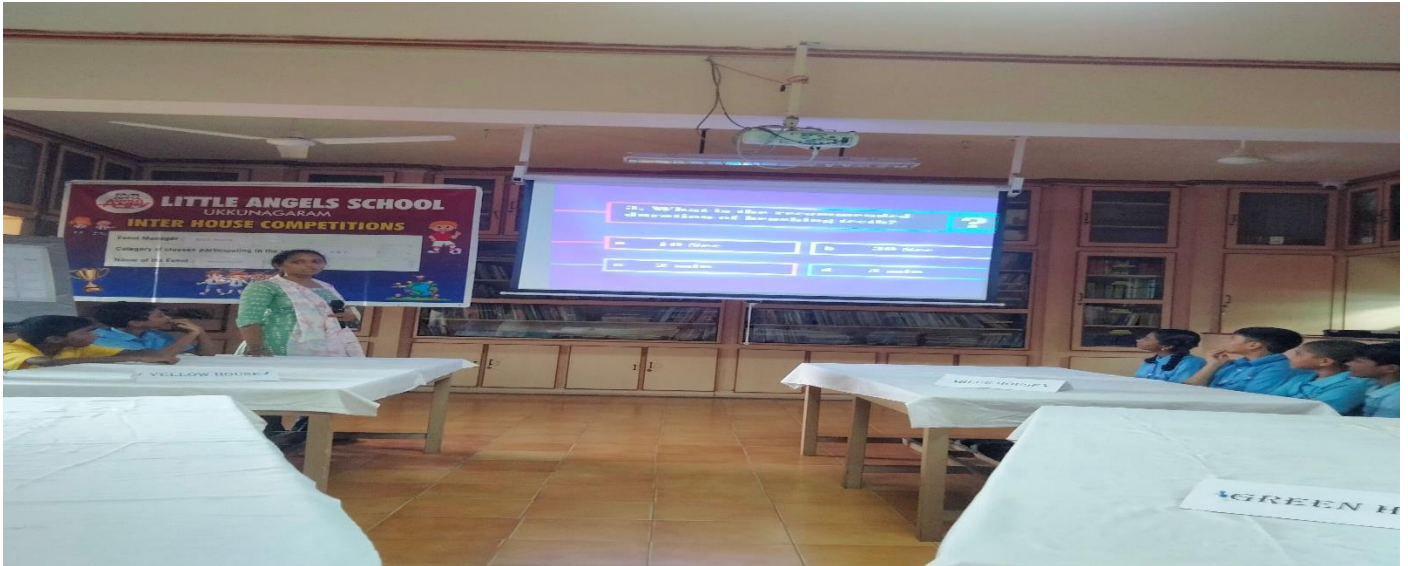
“BUZZERS READY, BRAIN STEADY”
