The girls enthusiastically took part in rangoli making competition , creating beautiful and colourful designs that reflected the cultural essence of Pongal and Bihu .

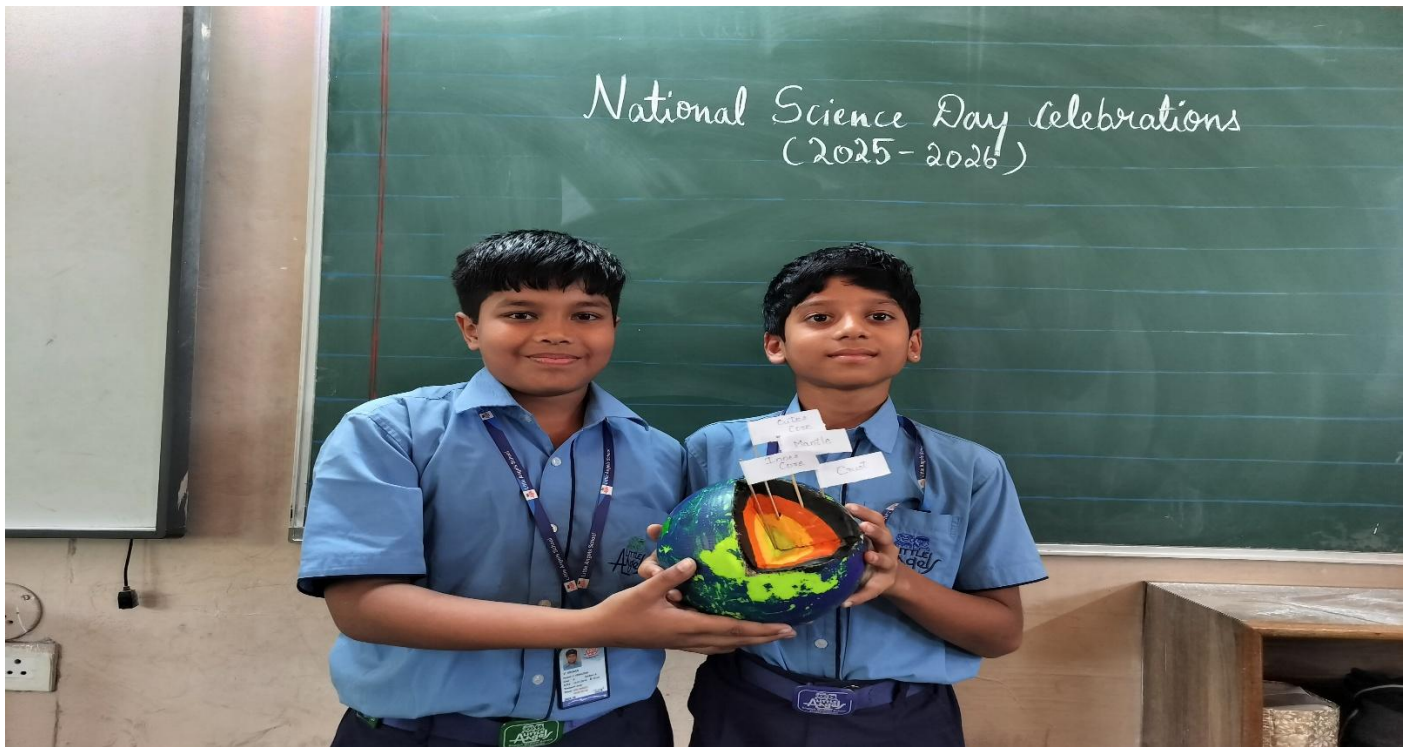


# “EVERY GREAT INVENTION BEGINS WITH CURIOSITY”

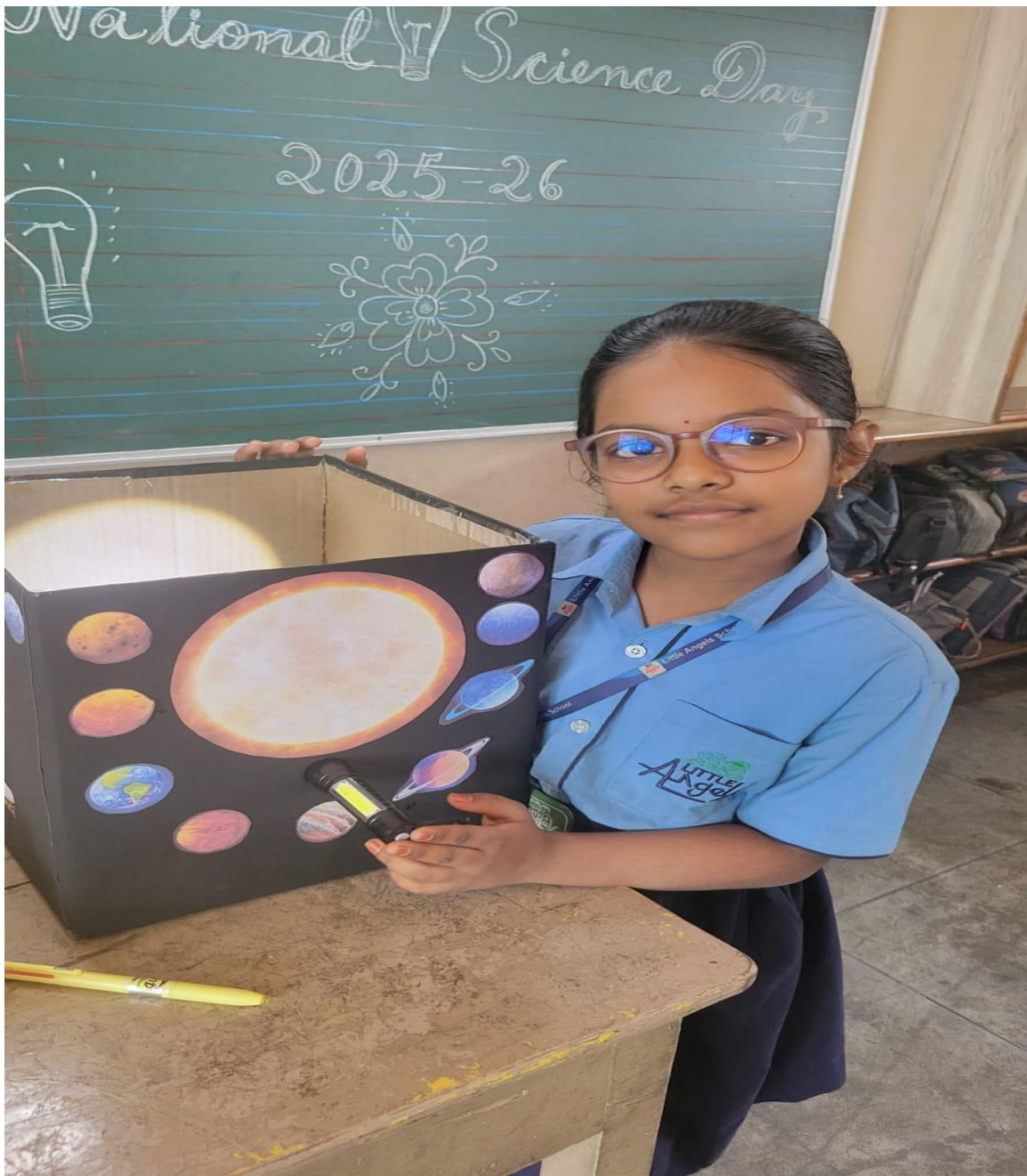
The students confidently explained their project in an elaborate and clear manner to the teachers & fellow students .

# “MUSIC FILLS THE SOUL WITH JOY AND PEACE “

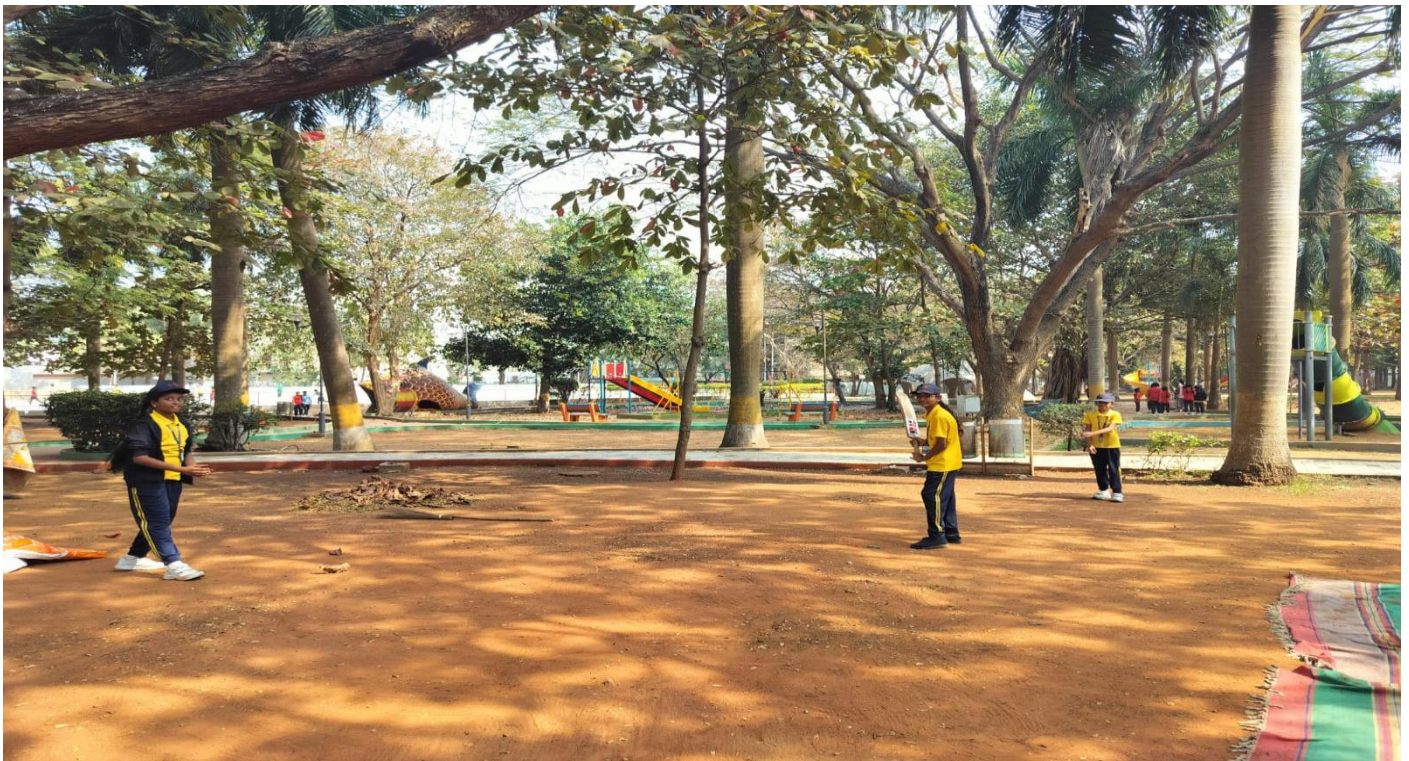


A Picnic to Shivaji park, Visakhapatnam was organized for the students of class 5 with the aim of providing them a refreshing break from routine classroom learning.
